# **EDUCATION**

### Boys & Girls Club of Tahleguah

Provides youth development to inspire, educate, and empower k-8th graders to realize their full potential as productive and responsible citizens in a safe and enjoyable environment.

#### **Dolly Parton Imagination Library**

Provides age appropriate books each month to children from birth to 5yrs to develop a love of reading during the early learning years to place them on a path towards a successful education experience.

#### Girl Scouts of Eastern Oklahoma

Community development program provides leadership skills, financial literacy, goal setting, and STEM based experiences for girls living in poverty.

#### **Muskogee County Council of Youth** Services (MCCOYS)

Provides guidance and character building programs for youth and young adults working within the judicial system and "Lifeskills" training for adolescent students at Braggs, Okay and Muskogee Public Schools.

#### **UMCH Circle of Care-PAL**

Provides a spectrum of transitional living assistance into early adulthood for at risk high school and college aged youth through an independent living program to successfully equip students for a working environment.

# **American Red Cross**

American Red Cross is a volunteer led humanitarian organization. United Way support touches lives daily with relief to victims of disasters, as well as emergency and prevention/ preparedness training.

#### Hope House of Cherokee County

Provides emergency food, shelter, and utility assistance to aid individuals and families in becoming self-sufficient.

#### Legal Aid Services Muskogee & Cherokee Counties

Provides free or low cost civil legal services to eligible low income residents and senior citizens.

#### Women in Safe Homes (WISH)

Provides shelter, counseling, and support services to victims of domestic violence, rape, and adult survivors of child sexual assault or harassment in order to achieve safety, survival, recovery, empowerment and rehabilitation to women and children coping with domestic violence.

#### CASA for Children-Muskogee

CASA recruits, screens, trains, and supports community volunteers to advocate in the best interests of children involved in juvenile cases of neglect and abuse in Muskogee, Wagoner & Sequoyah district courts.

### **CASA of Cherokee Country**

Advocating as a voice for children who enter the court system as a result of abuse/neglect by providing trained volunteers to speak independently for the best interests of the children.

#### Kelly B. Todd Cerebral Palsy & **Neuromuscular Center**

Provides children with motor deficit or developmental delays physical therapy to enhance mobility and interaction with friends and family.

#### Kids' Space Muskogee County Child **Advocacy Center**

Provides a child-friendly environment for the intervention, assessment, and investigation needed to assist with prosecution, treatment and prevention of physically and sexually abused children. Provides educational and child protective

#### RISE-Restoring Identities after Sexual Exploitation

RISE provides a safe, loving, long-term residence where minor victims of sex trafficking and/or commercial sexual exploitation live. They receive comprehensive, individualized services to permanently escape the world of the sex trade and become strong, independent, and responsible adults.

#### Volunteers of America-RSVP

Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) creates opportunities for senior citizens to remain actively engaged in their communities through volunteer services utilizing their time and talents in service to others.
